From February 2022 to April 2024, the ABCD4ME project has undertaken strategic actions to address the challenges faced by migrants in the over-regulated economic context of Europe. By supporting the development of digital entrepreneurship skills and qualifications, ABCD4ME aims to significantly contribute to the economic integration of migrants and provide them with opportunities for growth and development.

At present, the project is dynamically advancing through its pilot phase, actively executing and evaluating innovative methodologies, digital technologies, and educational resources meticulously crafted to empower migrants in the digital economy. The consortium has dedicated significant effort to guarantee the success of this pivotal pilot phase, meticulously laying the groundwork for the conclusive stage of the project.

As of April 2024, the ABCD4ME project will conclude its activities with a series of Multiplier Conferences. Online Digital Database For Migrant Entrepreneurship In A Digital Economy (ODD): A comprehensive repository of good practices, projects, methodologies, and policy guidelines, ODD stands as a valuable resource for potential digital entrepreneurs.

Theoretical Framework, Pedagogical Basis, And Training Curriculum: ABCD4ME has analyzed European Qualification Frameworks and National Qualification Frameworks for migrant entrepreneurship, defining a Competence Framework and proposing Learning Units for the Curriculum.

Digital Training Platform For Learning Via Apps For Migrant Entrepreneurship In A Digital Economy: The platform, designed with a focus on digital, gender, ethnic, linguistic, and cultural diversity, provides flexible learning opportunities and promotes digital innovation and intercultural entrepreneurship.

ABCD4ME Pedagogical Handbook: This handbook offers in-depth information, basic concepts, definitions, and methodological guidance to support the transferability, replication, and adaptation of digital teaching methods for migrant entrepreneurship education.
